we are “religious” but not according to what God asks of us in His word? Each of us needs to ask the question: Who is the authority? God? some preacher or church leader? me?

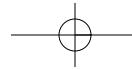
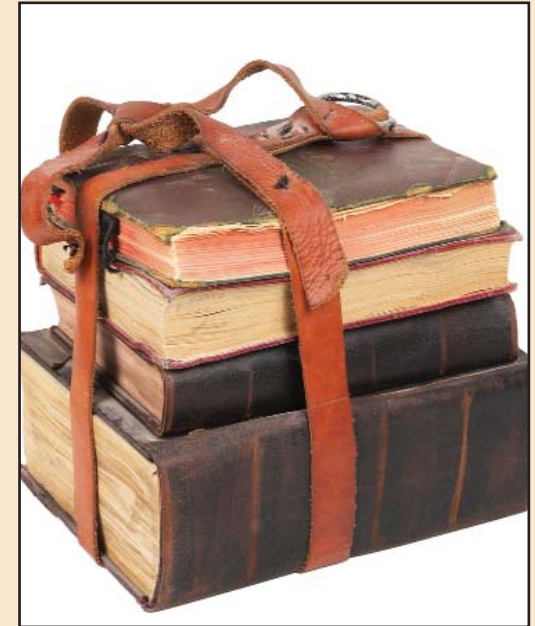
Surely the truths presented here are simple and easy to understand. Will you accept them, believe them and obey them? We pray that you will.

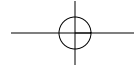
