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INTRODUCTION

The purpose of a sermon outline is not to encourage laziness or to serve as a substitute for Bible Study. Rather, it is an attempt to suggest a subject and a few points on which one can build his own sermon around.

You will note that this is not your usual sermon outline book. As the title suggests, these are literally sermon skeletons. There is a subject, a number of points are listed, along with appropriate scripture references, and then it is up to you to put the meat on it. This will definitely take study and effort on your part. It will come to life only if it is properly done.

Numerous titles are given but much of the material is repetitious. This will give you an opportunity to approach it from different points of view and to enlarge on it as you see fit. You may also choose to stay with the scripture references given or to substitute with others.

It is possible that you will find these outlines useful in radio work, sermons, talks, or on other occasions.
