

Where are the Miracles

While in Bangalore a few weeks ago, a radio preacher was being advertised for some meetings. It was said that he was anointed of God and would be conducting miracle healing services. Although I was there during the time he was, I heard of no miracles being performed. No one was talking about any miracles and neither did the newspaper carry any news of such happenings. Neither did I hear anyone say anything about these meetings. Had it not been for some advertising that I saw I would have never known anything about it. Where were the miracles then? Were there any performed? Don't you know that if there had been just one miracle during this meeting then everyone in Bangalore would have known about it? Everyone would have been talking about it. But this was not the case. Therefore I know, and all other honest people know, that no miracles were done, but if so, then they are but deceived.

Likewise in Madras I saw some hand bills pasted to various walls advertising a miracle healing campaign. By that time those meetings had already come and gone but I heard no one talking about any miracles that were done during this time. Had there been any miracles then all of Madras would have been excited about the things that had happened. But

friends, this was not the case and once more we must conclude that no miracles were performed.

Again in Colombo, Sri Lanka, there was talk of Ceylon Pentecostal Church, the Assemblies of God, and various ones conducting Charisma (Pentecostal) Services. It was said that the people should come expecting a miracle. I talked to a young lady who was of the Pentecostal persuasion and she said that the Lord had appeared to a Pastor Paul and revealed to him a plan for the unity of his people. She also know a preacher in Jaffna that I had known in years gone by and she said that God was working through him, but I happen to know that in the past he was of the Assemblies of God and had contacted me saying that he was interested in obeying the Lord to be added to his church, and he supposedly did that, but once he discovered that we were not willing to give him any financial help then all of a sudden he lost interest and returned to the Assemblies of God. He has quite a reputation in Sri Lanka for a number of things but some people think he is a servant of God and is able to perform miracles. How ridiculous!

Concerning all of this we are reminded again how easy it is for human beings to be deceived and led into false teaching. It is that way because so many are not only willing to be misled but even want to be deceived. Please think seriously concerning the things that are going to be said and consider them in light of what the Bible teaches.

It is interesting to see how different it was in the days of Christ and the Apostles. They performed miracles but they did no advertising, sent no one ahead to build up large audiences, asked for no one to come believing in miracles, or any such thing. The reason for this was because their miracles were not done merely to be popular or even to heal the sick. They did not preach that the people deserved perfect health and through their faith they could have such. Rather, they were dealing with unbelievers and the few miracles that they did were done to make believers out of them and to confirm the word. We read concerning the Apostles, "And they went forth, and preached every where, the Lord working with them,

and confirming the word with signs following. (Mark 16:20). The Hebrew writer says, "Therefore we ought to give the more earnest heed to the things which we have heard, lest any time we should let them slip. For if the word spoken by angels was steadfast, and every transgression and disobedience received a just recompense of reward; How shall we escape, if we neglect so great salvation; which at the first began to be spoken by the Lord and was confirmed unto us by them that heard him. God also bearing them witness, both with signs and wonders, and with divers miracles, and gifts of the Holy Ghost, according to his own will?" (Hebrews 2:1-4). The New Testament had not been given at that time and so the signs, wonders, and miracles were done to confirm the Apostles teaching or to prove to the people that they were indeed preaching the word of God. But what about today? We have the New Testament now. Has it been confirmed? Most certainly. Therefore, there is no purpose for miracles now. Neither does God appear to anyone today, or speak to anyone apart from his word because we have the word of God, it has already been confirmed to be the word of God. and therefore he speaks to us through that word. God speaks to us today through his Son (Hebrews 1:1.2; Matthew 17:5), it has been written down and completely furnishes man to every good work (2 Timothy 3:16,17;2 Peter 1:3; James 1:25), we are to read and study it to know the truth and to believe it (2 Timothy 2:15; John 17:17; John 8:32; Romans 10:17), and it is not to be changed in any way. (Revelation 22:18,19). Therefore, those who claim to perform miracles today are imposters. Likewise, those who claim that God has spoken to them separate and apart from the word are false teachers. Like Pastor Paul, who said God has spoken directly to him and had given him a special plan for unity. The Lord had already prayed for such unity and the New Testament has contained the plan for unity since the days of the Apostles. (John 17; Ephesians 4:1-6). Why then would the Lord speak to him and give him a special plan? The scriptures also say that by their fruits ye shall know them (Matthew 7:16), and this Pastor Paul was but a preacher, not a scriptural Pastor

(1 Timothy 3:1-7), who promoted the Ceylon Pentecostal Church, is in opposition to the church we read about in the Bible, and contrary to God's plan for unity, and he taught that the Lord had spoken directly to him which would make the Lord a respector of persons and also mean that the Bible is not complete. All of this marks him as a false teacher.

Listen to the inspired word of God: "Now we beseech you, brethren, by the coming of our Lord Jesus Christ, and by our gathering together unto him; That ye be not soon shaken in mind, or be troubled, neither by spirit, nor by word, nor by letter as from us, as that the day of Christ is at hand. Let no man deceive you by any means: for that day shall not come except there come a falling away first, and that man of sin be revealed, the son of perdition; Who opposeth and exalteth himself above all that is called God, or that is worshipped; so that he as God sitteth in the temple of God, shewing himself that he is God. Remember ye not, that, when I was yet with you, I told you these things? And now ye know what with holdeth that he might be revealed For the mystery of iniquity doth already work; only he who now letteth will let, until he be taken out of the And then shall that Wicked be revealed, whom the Lord shall consume with the spirit of his mouth, and shall destroy with the brightness of his coming: Even him, whose coming is after the working of Satan with all power and signs and lying wonders, And with all deceivableness of unrighteousness in them that perish; because they received not the love of the truth, that they might be saved. And for this cause God shall send them strong delusion, that they should believe a lie; That they all might be damned who believed not the truth, but had pleasure in unrighteousness." (2 Thessalonians 2:1-12). Again, Paul writes, "Now the Spirit speaketh expressly, that in the latter times some shall depart from the faith, giving heed to seducing spirits, and doctrines of devil; Speaking lies In hypocrisy; having their conscience seared with a hot iron..." (1 Timothy 4:1,2). Continuing, he says, "I charge thee therefore before God, and the Lord Jesus Christ, who shall judge the quick and the dead at his appearing and his kingdom; Preach the word; be instant in season, out of season; reprove, rebuke, exhort with all longsuffering and doctrine. For the time will come when they will not endure sound doctrine; but after their own lusts shall they heap to themselves teachers, having itching ears; And they shall turn away their ears from the truth, and shall be turned unto fables." (2 Timothy 4:1-4). And finally, listen to Christ himself, "Not every one that saith unto me, Lord, Lord, shall enter into the kingdom of heaven; but he that doeth the will of my Father which is in heaven. Many will say to me in that day, Lord, Lord, have we not prophesied in thy name? And in they name have cats out devils? and in thy name done many wonderful works? And then will I profess unto them, I never knew you; depart from me, ye that work iniquity." (Matthew 7:21-23).

One and all would do well to take note of the foregoing scriptures, and many others that could be given, that show that it is easy to be deceived and misled. This is true not only in the case of miracles but with many other points of doctrine as well. But if you will observe those who teach that miracles can be performed today, you will find that they claim to have the baptism of the Holy Spirit, but then they are in churches that the Bible knows nothing about, wear man-made names and titles, claim that the Lord speaks directly to them, but his message to them is always contrary to the scriptures, and so this would mark them as imposters. Furthermore, you will discover that there are many number of groups who claim to work miracles by the guidance of the Holy Spirit, yet they condemn and oppose one another. There are even some in most every denomination who make such claims. The question, therefore, would be this: Would the Holy Spirit guide and direct different ones into different groups, to teach different things, and to oppose one another? If so, then the Holy Spirit opposes himself. I think you would have to admit though that if such people have a spirit it is definitely not the Holy Spirit.

Of course these people would come back and say that we do not believe in the power of God today, since we do not believe in miracles, but this is false. We do believe in God,

and we believe in the power of God, but God does not choose to work today through miracles as he did in the past. It is not that he could not do miracles if he chose to do so. He created the first man from the dust of the earth, and he could still create human beings like that if he wanted to, but he doesn't have to prove that he is God and that he is all powerful because he has already proven himself, and furthermore he now works through the law of nature to create men and women. He could also heal the sick, restore eye sight, raise the dead, etc., if he chose to do so but there is no purpose for doing so. He works now through his word to teach, to make believers, to save, and to give hope. What would miracles prove? Even when used they were spoken of as being childish things that would cease. (1 Corinthians 13:8-12). And so they have.

Contrary to the belief of some, there are no miracles being performed today. If so, where are the miracles being performed? On whom? By whom? What is their purpose? Let me encourage you to return to God's word, study it, believe it, and obey it and you will find that there is more than enough power to save you and to give you the hope of eternal life. For what more could you ask?



Should Christians use Mechanical Instruments of Music in their Worship

Some time back in one of my radio talk, over radio Sri Lanka, when I pointed to the fact that Christians should not use mechanical instruments of music in their worship, a man wrote me a letter in which he tried to justify its use in Christian worship and argued that we can worship the Lord acceptably with and without mechanical instruments of music. Supporting the use of mechanical instruments of music in Christian worship he reasond and said:

"I do not accept that Jesus has ever condemned the use of musical instruments anywhere nor any apostles said so."

But does it mean that we should use a thing because the Lord has not specifically condemned it, or that he hasn't said. "Do not use mechanical instruments of music in worship"? Let me ask you, to make it clear what I mean, Can I use Cocacola or Fanta instead of the fruit of the vine and fried finger chips instead of unleavened bread in the Lord's Supper? You might say, I am speaking blasphemy. But friend, Jesus or the apostles never said that we cannot use Cocacola, Fanta. and finger chips in the Lord's Supper, they never did condemn their use. But does this fact gives me liberty to go ahead and use them? The fact is, that they have told us what to use in the Lord's Supper, and this should be enough to eliminate any other thing in it. Ephesians 5:19 says, "Speaking to yourselves in psalms and hymns and spiritual songs, singing and making melody in your heart to the Lord." So we are to sing and make melody or music in our heart and not on a piano or guitar. The Point is that he does not necessarily has to say: "Not to use Mechanical instruments of music." There are many things that Jesus has not specifically condemned, but this does not mean that we can use them or practice them, because he did not.

Secondly, he said, "I appreciate singing without music (Mechanical Instruments of music), and that it should be with heart, but this degree of worship can also be achieved and created while singing with music."

But friend, one cannot worship (sing) with spirit, (John 4:24; 1 Corinthians 14:15), with mechanical instruments of music. When one sing and play an instrument he does not only concentrate on singing (or words) but he also has to concentrate on the mechanical instrument that he is playing. Is this not true? The fact is, one cannot give his whole heart in singing, in worship, when he is playing an instrument of

music. His spirit might be in worship but his mind will be concentrating on the instrument that he is playing.

Then in the third place, he mentioned the book of Psalms, and said, David used mechanical instruments of music in worship.

Yes, he did. But who was David? He was not a Christian. He did not live under the law of Christ, the New Testament, but he lived under the Old Testament law of Moses. Back in the Old Testament days they used in their worship many other things also, such as animal sacrifices, burning of incense, etcetra. Now if we can bring mechanical instruments of music in Christian worship from the Old Testament, then why not bring also the animal sacrifices and the other things as well? Remember, we live today under the new Testament and not under the Old Testament. Therefore our worship should be entirely according to the New Testament teachings. God has commanded us to hear Jesus. (Matthew 17:5). We are not to hear Moses or David, but we are to hear Jesus. The question is, did Jesus or his apostles command (again not condemn) the use of mechanical instruments of music in worship? No.

Fourthly, his reasoning was, "I think the use of mechanical instruments of music was not so popular with the early church. Now the age has advanced and with the incoming of different types of musical instruments, and to aid the worship, these are being used which should not be taken as incorrect."

First of all, it is wrong to state that music was not popular, or not known, in the first century. Going through the various books of Old Testament one read of scores of musical instruments. Perhaps they were more popular then than now in our age. However, when it comes to the Christian worship it does not mean a thing what is popular and what is not for instance, we do not worship because worship is popular, but because we have been commanded to do so. We do not pray, give of our means, take the Lord's Supper, study the Bible, and sing in our worship just because they are popular. Again, does it mean I can use Cocacola in the Lord's Supper, because Christ

did not condemn it's use, and because it was not so popular omong the early Christians? One can reason, and say, but now the age has advanced, so why not use coffee, cookies, and even liquor, in Lord's Supper, of course they weren't Popular then. But we know that in doing so we will add into what Jesus has commanded. And the same is true with Mechanical instruments of music, they are not aid, as some say, but ADD, when we bring and use them in Christian worship. And "If any man shall add unto these things, (things written in N.T.), God shall add unto him the plagues that are written in this book." (Revelation 22.18).

And lastly, he said, "I am myself a singer and I always use musical instruments while preaching." if I leave musical instruments, I will have to leave preaching, also as I will be left alone without the party, and I feel it will not have much effect on the mob..."

Obviously, the person who reasons so is putting more importance on the musical instruments rather than the Bible. However, I wonder, if Peter had in his hand a harp, on the day of Pentecost, when he converted 3000 souls? Or what mechanical instrument of music did Philip play when he converted the Ethiopean Eunuch of Acts chapter 8? Is there any example in the entire New Testament where a single soul was ever brought to Christ through the use of mechanical instruments of music? Remember, it is the Bible, "The word of the Lord is quick, and powerful and sharper than any two edged Sword, Piercing even to the dividing asunder of soul and spirit, and of the joint and marrow, and is a discerner of the thoughts and intents of the heart." (Hebrews 4:12).

When Peter preached the word on pentecost, 3000 people repented of their sins and were baptized for the remission of their sins. (Acts 2). However, Stephen was stoned to death when he preached the same word. (Acts 7). No doubt, the Lord has said, "My word shall not return unto me void," (Isaiah 55:11). It will always have some kind of effect on the listeners. Remember, again, it is the Bible, the Word of the Lord, that is effective in the saving of the souls and not a

mechanical instrument of music. The man who says, "If I leave Mechanical instruments of music I will have to leave preaching also", is certainly not a preacher, he is a player.

The scripture says, "Whosoever transgresseth (goeth onward) and abideth not in the doctrine (teachings) of Christ, hath not God. He that abideth in the doctrine of Christ, he hath both the Father and the Son." (2 John 9).

Where do you stand on these matters? If you have not yet completely yielded yourself to the Lord then you should, "Repent, and be baptized in the name of Jesus Christ for the remission of sins". (Acts 2:38). Or if you have already obeyed him, but have been in errors on these matters, then you should, "Repent therefore of this thy wickedness, and pray God, if perhaps the thought of thine heart may be forgiven thee." (Acts 8:22).

Are You Sure?

Concerning Heaven.

Probably most people expect to enjoy a happy home after this life shall have come to an end. Probably you feel that when you come to die you will have met the requirements that heaven might be your eternal home.

Are You Sure?

The only reliable source of information concerning heaven is the Bible. The Bible tells about heaven, and who is going there. The Bible also indicates that comparatively few people will ever reach heaven.

Jesus said, as recorded in the Bible, Matthew chapter 7, verses 13 and 14: "Enter ye in at the strait gate: for wide is the gate, and broad is the way, that leadeth to destruction, and many there be which go in thereat: Because strait is the gate, and narrow is the way, which leadeth unto life, and few there be that find it".

Many Disappointments

In the same 7th chapter of Matthew, verses 22 and 23, the Bible tells us that Jesus said: "Many will say to me in that day, Lord, Lord, have we not prophesied in thy name? and in thy name have cast out devils? and in thy name done many wonderful works? And then will I profess unto them, I never knew you: depart from me, ye that work iniquity".

Many Churches

Those who have tried to count them tell us there are hundreds of separate religious organizations claiming to be followers of Christ. Their doctrines differ widely, often conflicting. Can all these be right? The Bible tells us that Jesus said of some worshipers: "But in vain they do worship me, teachting for doctrines the commandments of men" (Matt. 15:9). Is it not evident that hunderds of religious organizations (churches)—originated by men and women far this side of Bible times—are "teaching for doctrines the commandments of men"? Are you a member of such an organization? Probably, you do not think so. Are you sure? A careful comparison of your creed with the word of God is kindly suggested.

"Church of Your Choice"

Can we accept the popular opinions of many religious people that the doctrine makes little difference, and that "one church is as good as another?" Jesus said, as recorded in the Bible: "Upon this rock I will build my church; and the gates of hell shall not prevail against it" (Matthew 16:18). In Ephesians 1:22, 23, we learn that the church is the body of Christ; and in chapter 5, verse 23, we read that: "he is the saviour of the body." In Ephesians, chapter 4, verses 4, 5, and 6, it is recorded, the apostle said: "There is one body, and one Spirit, even as ye are called in one hope of your calling; One Lord, one faith, one baptism, One God and Father of all, who is above all, and through all, and in you all." This was written to "the faithful in Christ Jesus," as we learn from Eph. 1:1.

Jesus built one church for all the saved for all the rest of

time. What right has any man or woman ever had to build another church? The church which Jesus built, "he hath purchased with his own blood" (Acts 20:28). Are you seeking the church of your choice? What would be the Lord's choice in this vital matter?

Many Doctrines

Many people think that the religious organization, the church, the "faith," makes little difference, so long as one is sincere. But the Bible tells us that Jesus said: "Ye shall know the truth, and the truth shall make you free" (John 8:32).

The Bible also tells us that Jesus said in a prayer to God: "Sanctify them through thy truth: thy word is truth" (John 17:17). Sincerity does not change error into truth. Jesus said to His disciples: "The time cometh, that whosoever killeth you will think that he doeth God's service" (John 16:2).

The Bible and Baptism

Many people think that baptism has nothing to do with salvation. But Jesus said, as recorded in the Bible: "He that believeth and is baptized shall be saved; but he that believeth not shall be damned" (Mark 16:16). Jesus said also, as recorded in Matthew, chapter 28, last two verses: "Go ye therefore, and teach all nations, baptizing them in the name of the Father, and of the Son, and of the Holy Ghost: Teaching them to observe all things whatsover I have commanded you: and, lo, I am with you alway, even unto the end of the world." Jesus has not promised to save one who refuses, or neglects, to be baptized. And remember, dear friend, that it is not recorded in the Bible that Jesus ever used this phrase: "in the name of the Father, and of the Son, and of the Holy Ghost," in connection with any other command than that of baptism. It is recorded in the Bible, 1 Peter, chapter 3, verse 21, that an apostle of Jesus said: "baptism doth also now save us....." No, he did not say baptism alone. Baptism alone does not save, any more than faith alone, or any other one thing alone:

but, according to the Bible, word of God, baptism is one of the things required of a sinner in order that he may be saved. No one who has a proper understanding and reverence for the word of God will speak lightly of baptism.

Much Water

Many people think that sprinkling or pouring will answer for baptism, You may be one of those who feel that immersion is not essential. Are you sure?

The Bible shows clearly that the baptism commanded by Jesus and His inspired apostles is a burial in water, and a resurrection from the water, of a penitent believer, obeying a form of the death, burial and resurrection of Jesus. Read in your Bible. John 3:5; Acts of the apostles, chapter eight, verses twenty six through thirty nine; Romans, chapter six, first eighteen verses. Then turn to Colossians, chapter two. verse twelve, and read: "Buried with him in baptism, wherein also ye are risen with him through the faith of the operation of God, who hath raised him from the dead." Farther down a few verses, in verse one of chapter three, read: "If ye then be risen with Christ, seek those things which are above, where Christ sitteth on the right hand of God." Friend, if you have not been raised with Christ in baptism, when and how were vou raised with Him? The Bible says, too, that: "John also was baptizing in Aenon near to Salim, because there was much water there" (John 3:23). Nothing short of a burial in water will fit these Scriptures. Does someone guess that immersion is not necessary? Why risk eternity upon a guess? Rather, open your Bible and see what God's word has to sav. and do what God's word says to do. There is no promise from God outside of His word.

Faith only?

Many think that salvation is by faith only. But the Bible tells us of Jesus that: "He became the author of eternal salvation unto all them that obey him" (Heb. 5:9). And Jesus said: "Not every one that saith unto me, Lord, Lorp,

shall enter into the kingdom of heaven; but he that doeth the will of my Father which is in heaven" (Matt. 7:21). And in the Bible we find this statement: "Ye see then how that by works a man is justified, and not by faith only" (James 2:24).

Can one fall?

Many think that a child of God cannot fall and be lost. Is this true? The Bible answers. The word of God warns: "Wherefore let him that thinketh he standeth take heed lest he fall" (1 Cor. 10: 12). The apostle Paul also wrote: "Christ is become of no effect unto you, whosoever of you are justified by the law; ye are fallen from grace" (Gal. 5:4). Paul wrote also: "If ye live after the flesh, ye shall die : but if ye through the Spirit do mortify the deeds of the body, ye shall live" (Rom. 8:13). And Paul wrote of himself: "I keep under my body, and bring it into subjection; lest that by any means, when I have preached to others, I myself should be a castaway" (I Cor. 9:27). And he said, as recorded in Rom. 11:22: "Behold therefore the goodness and severity of God : Ion them which fell, severity; but toward thee, goodness, if thou continue in his goodness: otherwise thou also shalt be cut off." And the Bible tells us that Jesus said: "If a man abide not in me, he is cast forth as a branch, and is withered: and men gather them, and cast them into the fire, and they are burned" (John 15: 6).

Faith or Opinion?

My dear friend, why risk your eternal salvation upon the opinions of men? The Bible tells us of some that; "These were more noble than those in Thessalonica, in that they received the word with all readiness of mind, and searched the scriptures daily, whether those things were so" (Acts 17:11). The Bible tells us that: "faith cometh by hearing, and hearing the word of God" (Rom. 10:17). Then let us learn what the word of God says, and have enough faith to accept the salvation offered by Jesus, upon His terms. There is no other salvation promised. We should have enough faith to repent of sins, (Luke 13:3), to confess Jesus Christ before men, (Matt. 10:32), and be bap-

tized into Christ, (Rom. 6:3; Gal. 3:27). Those who do these things from the heart are saved from past sins to live for God. They are added by the Lord, (Acts 2: 47), to the other obedient believers, baptized into the one body, (1 Cor. 12:13), which is the church. (Col. 1 : 24), the one you can read about in your Bible. The church of the New Testament is not a denomination. Jesus said of it: "I will build my church" (Matt. 16: 18). It is the body of Christ, (Eph. 1:22,23; Col. 1: 18). In one instance the apostle Paul, concerning local congregations of the Lord's church, used the term "churches of Christ" (Rom. 16:16). The Lord's church is also called "the church of God" in the New Testament, as in 1 Cor. 1:2; and other are used denoting ownership, location, or certain characteristics of the church; but usually it is referred simply as the church, there being only one. it is the Lord's church. It is the church of Christ. (Rom. 16: 16).

Be Faithful

Then, having become obedient to the Lord, through faith, repentance and baptism; let us be faithful in the Lord's church "unto death," (Rev. 2: 10), and look forward to a home with Him in that place which He has gone to prepare, (John 14:1-3). The Bible tells us of this home: "And God shall whipe away all tears from their eyes; and there shall be no more death, neither sorrow, nor crying, neither shall there be any more pain: for the former things are passed away" (Rev. 21:4). But the Bible tells us of a lake of fire. It is recorded in the Bible that Jesus will say to some: "Depart from me, ve cursed, into ever lasting fire, prepared for the devil and his angels" (Matt. 25:41). And near the close of the New Testament we find this prophecy: "And whosoever was not found written in the book of life was cast into the lake of fire" (Rev. 20:15).

How can I win my companion to Christ? This question has been asked by countless Christians married to unbelievers. Regardless of how happy it may be, a religiously divided home can never enjoy the happiness that it could if that condition did not exist. Furthermore, the chances are better than even that the division in the home is a source of chronic discord between husband and wife.

The Christian married to a non-Christian is naturally concerned about the harmony in the home. But he is even more disturbed about the spiritual condition of that loved one out of Christ. A child of God who places real trust in the divine promises realizes that the eternal destiny of his mate depends upon that one's obedience to the gespel.

A divided home sometimes results when one of the marriage partners in a non-Christian home is converted. More often, however, it is the consequence of a child of God marrying out of Christ. In thousands of cases the faith of the Christian has not proved equal to the will of his companion. The result is that the disciple of Christ has been lost to Him, to the church—and to heaven. The very least that can be said is

that the Christian who marries out of the Lord jeopardizes his chance of eternal life. Certainly he lessens his value to the kingdom of God. The unhappy experiences of those who have married unbelievers should serve as a grave warning to all young Christians contemplating marriage.

We ought not to suppose, however, that it is impossible for one to win his companion to the Lord. Some of the most consecrated Christians are those who have been converted through the efforts of their mates. Many more could be won if their Christian companions only understood and practiced a few basic principles necessary for their conversion. The following suggestions are offered to Christians married to unbelievers in the hope that they may aid in the salvation of their companions:

- 1. You cannot drive one to accept Christ. The power of the gospel is a drawing force, not a driving one. Jesus taught. "No man can come to me, except the Father that sent me draw him." (John 6:44.) Some Christians are so filled with concern for the spiritual welfare of their mates that they use poor judgment and exert too much pressure. The non-Christian may revolt and bring out the stubborn nature that all of us possess to some extent. Furthermore, you surely would not want your companion to go through the form of obeying the gospel just to please you. Not only would his action not help him, but it might well hinder his genuine conversion at a later date.
- 2. Don't be dogmatic. Over-positiveness which fails to consider the thinking of the other person often does more harm than good. How many people have remarked. "I can't believe the way you do because you think only members of your church are going to heaven." The chances are that the one teaching him overstated his case. The best way to answer this objection is to say. "Let's let the Lord decide who will be saved. The important thing for us is to be sure that we do what He commands us."
 - 3. Study the Word of God. Some unbelievers are never

won to Christ because their husbands or wives are not equipped to teach them. A preacher or elder can do much to help, but there is no adequate substitute for what you can do yourself in teaching your companion, provided that you are acquainted with the Bible. Be "ready always to give answer... concerning the hope that is in you, yet with meekness and fear." (I Peter 3:15.)

- 4. You will never win your companion by staying away from the place of worship. Regardless of how much opposition you may receive at home, your mate will not respect your religious convictions unless he sees you regularly and faithfully worshipping with other Christians. If you forsake such assembling with your brethren, you will not only fail to win his soul, but you will also lose your own.
- 5. The best way to win an unbeliever is to set a chaste example. "In like manner, ye wives, be in subjection to your own husbands; that even if any obey not the word, they may without the word be gained by the behaviour of their wives; beholding your chaste behaviour coupled with fear." (1 Peter 3:1, 2.) Many wives have won their husbands, and husbands their wives, by the examples of pure Christian living they have shown.
- 6. Be patient. Many companions have been converted only after months of work and prayer. If you do not win your mate immediately, do not become discouraged and quit trying. That soul is too important for you to give up. He may in time accept Christ. "God moves in a mysterious way His wonders to perform."
- 7. Pray. You will need help in winning your loved one to Christ, help from your brethren, and especially, help from God. Never forget to entreat the Father in your prayers for that one who means more to you than any other earthly soul. "Ask, and it shall be given you; seek, and ye shall find; knock, and it shall be opened unto you." (Matt. 7:7.)

Put Away Childish Things

The apostle Paul wrote in I Cor. 13:11, "when I was a child, I spake as a child, I felt as a child, I thought as a child; now that I am become a man, I have put away childish things." And this is what supposedly is to take place in each person's life. As we grow older, we are to start acting, thinking, and feeling like adults instead of like children.

The way that a lot of people act today reminds me of a man in the Old Testament. One day king Ahab decided that he wanted the vineyard of Naboth the Jezreelite, and so Ahab asked Naboth for the vineyard and offerd him his choice of a better vineyard or of the money it was worth in exchange for the vineyard. But Naboth refused because the vineyard was the inheritance of his fathers.

Now notice how king Ahab reacted— I Kings 21:4: "And Ahab came into his house, heavy and displeased because of the word which Naboth the Jezreelite had spoken to him: for he said, I will not give thee the inheritance of my fathers.

And he laid him down upon his bed, and turned away his face, and would eat not bread."

Can you imagine! The king pouting like that! He laid upon his bed, turned away his face, and refused to eat anything. But do you know what? I have seen a lot of "adults!" act in the same kind of way when things did not go exactly like they wanted them to go. Isn't it high time that we began to speak, feel, and think as adults as we put away the childish thing? Especially in the Lord's church?

मूर्ति-पूजा का पाप

एक मूर्ति, लकड़ी, पत्थर या किसी अन्य वस्तु के द्वारा बनाया गया एक स्वरूप है, जिसे किसी "देवता" या "देवी" का प्रतीक समभा जाता है। इसे किसी मनुष्य के रूप में, या सृष्टि के किसी एक भाग के रूप में, या किसी अन्य ऐसी वस्तु के रूप में भी, जिसके लिये मनुष्य अपना समय दे और, जिसकी वह उपासना करे, पाया जा सकता है। उपासना में मूर्तिपूजा का स्थान उतना ही पुराना है जितना कि प्राचीन-काल और उतना ही नया है जितना की आधुनिक-काल। इसे कई प्रकार से व्यवहार में लाया जाता है, परन्तु क्योंकि यह मूर्तिपूजा है इसलिये यह पाप है, क्योंकि मूर्तिपूजा करके लोग एक ऐसी वस्तु की उपासना करते हैं जो सच्चा व जीवता परमेश्वर नहीं है।

मूर्तियों के विषय में बाइबल कहती है, "तू श्रपने लिये कोई मूर्ति खोदकर न बनाना, न किसी की प्रतिमा बनाना, जो श्राकाश में व पृथ्वी पर, वा पृथ्वी के जल में है। तू उनको दन्डवत न करना; श्रीर न उनकी उपासना करना, क्योंकि मैं तेरा परमेश्वर यहोवा जलन रखने वाला ईश्वर हूं।" (निर्गमन २०: ४, ५)। "सो इस्त्राएल के घराने से कह, प्रमु यहोवा यों कहता है, फिरो श्रीर श्रपनी मूर्तों को पीठ के पीछे करो; श्रीर श्रपने सब घृणित कामों से मुंह भोड़ों।" (यहेजकेल १४:६)।

इसी विषय पर नए नियम के लेखक धागे कहते है: "इसलिये मेरा विचार यह है कि, अन्य जातियों में से जो लोग परमेश्वर की धोर फिरते हैं, हम उन्हें दुख न दे। परन्तु उन्हें लिख मेर्जे, कि वे मूर्तों की ध्रशुद्धताओं और व्यभिचार और गला घोटे हुओं के मास से धौर लोहू से परे रहें। (प्रेरितों १५:१६-२०)। "हे बालको, अपने आप को मूरतों से बचाए रखो।" (१ यहन्ना ५:२१)।

पित्र लेखक मूर्तों तथा उनकी उपासना की मूर्खता को इस प्रकार कहकर दर्शाते हैं: "उनका देश मूर्तों से भरा है; वे ग्रपने हाथों की बनाई हुई वस्तुग्रों को जिन्हें उन्होंने ग्रपनी उंगलियों से सवारा है, दन्डवत करते हैं।

इस से मनुष्य भूकते, और बड़े मनुष्य प्रणाम करते हैं, इस कारण उनको क्षमा न कर।" (यशायाह २:५,६)। "जो मूरत खोदकर बनाते हैं, वे सब के सब व्यर्थ हैं और जिन वस्तुओं में वे म्रानन्द ढूंढ़ते उन से कुछ लाम न होगा; उनके साक्षी, न तो भ्राप कुछ देखते भीर न कुछ जानते हैं, इसलिये उनको लिजत होना पड़ेगा। किस ने देवता वा निषफल मूरत ढाली है ? देख, उसके सब संगियों को तो लिज्जित होना पड़ेगा, करीगर तो मनुष्य ही हैं ; वे सब के सब इकट्ठे होकर खड़े हों ; वे डर जाएंगे ; वे सब के सब लज्जित होंगे । लोहार एक बसूला श्रंगारों में बनता श्रीर हाथौड़ों से गढ़कर तैयार करता है, अपने भुजबल से वह उसको बनाता है ; फिर वह मूखा हो जाता है ग्रीर उसका बल घटता है, वह पानी नहीं पीता ग्रीर थक जाता है । बढ़ई सूत लगाकर टांकी से रेखा करता है ग्रीर रन्दनी से काम करता ग्रीर ... परकार से रेखा खींचता है, वह उसका श्राकार ग्रौर मनुष्य की सी सुंदरता बनाता है ताकि लोग उसे घर में रखें। वह देवदार को काटता वा वन के वृक्षों में से जाति-जाति के बांजवृक्ष चुनकर सेवता है, वह एक तूस का वृक्ष लगाता है जो वर्षा का जल पाकर बढ़ता है। तब वह मनुष्य के ईंघन के काम में ग्राता है ; वह उस में से कुछ सुलगाकर तापता है, वह उसको जलाकर रोटी बनाता है; उसी से वह देवता भी बनाकर उसको दन्डवत करता है ; वह मूरत खुदवाकर उसके सामने प्रणाम करता है। उसका एक भाग तो वह ग्राग में जलाता ग्रौर दूसरे भाग से मांस पकाकर खाता है, वह मांस मूनकर तुप्त होता ; फिर तापकर कहता है, म्राहा, मैं गर्म हो गया, मैं ने ग्राग देखी हैं ! ग्रीर उसके बचे हुए माग को लेकर वह एक देवता ग्रर्थात् एक मूत खोदकर बनाता है ; तब वह उसके सामने प्रणाम श्रीर दन्डवत करता ग्रीर उस से प्रार्थना करके कहता है, मुक्ते बचा ले, क्योंकि तू मेरा देवता है ! वे कुछ नहीं जानते, न कुछ समभ रखते हैं ; क्योंकि उनकी स्राखें ऐसी मूदी गई हैं कि वे देख नहीं सकते ; श्रीर उनकी बुद्धी ऐसी कि वे बूफ नहीं सकते । कोई इस पर घ्यान नहीं करता, ग्रीर न किसी को इतना ज्ञान व समफ रहती है कि कह सके, उसका एक भाग तो मैं ने जला दिया भौर उसके कोयलों पर रोटी बनाई ; भ्रौर मांस भूनकर सोया ; फिर क्या मैं उसके बचे हुए भाग को घिनौनी वस्तु बनाऊं ? क्या मैं काठ को प्रणाम करूं ? वह राख खाता हैं ; मरमाई हुई बुद्धि के कारण वह भटकाया गया है ग्रीर वह न ग्रपने को बचा सकता ग्रीर न यह कह सकता है, क्या मेरे दहिने हाथ में मिथ्या नहीं ? (यशायाहा ४४:६-२०) ।

इसी बात की मूर्खता के विषय में दाऊद ने यूं लिखा: "हे यहोवा हमारी

बाले भी वैसे ही हो जाए गे।" (भजन ११५:१-८)। जैसी वे हैं वैसे ही उनके बनाने वाले हैं ; श्रीर उन पर सब भरोसा रखने हैं परन्तु वे देख नहीं सकतीं। उनके कान तो रहते हैं, परन्तु वेसुन नहीं चल नहीं सकतीं ; श्रौर श्रपने कंठ से कुछ भी शब्द नहीं निकाल सकतीं। रहते हैं, परन्तु वे स्पर्श नहीं कर सकती ; उनके पांव तो रहते हैं, परन्तु वे सकतीं ; उनके नाक तो रहती है परन्तु वे सुंघ नहीं सकतीं। उनके हाथ तो हैं। उनके मुंह तो रहता है परन्तु वे बोल नहीं सकतीं ; उनके आंखें तो रहती रहा है हमारा परमेश्वर तो स्वर्ग में हैं ; उसने जो चाहा वही किया है। उन लोगों की मूरतें सोने-चान्दी ही की तो हैं, वे मनुष्यों के हाथ की बनाई हुई के निमित्त कर । जाति-जाति के लोंग क्यों कहने पाएं, कि उनका परमेश्वर कहां नहीं, हमारी नहीं, बरन श्रपने ही नाम की महिमा, श्रपनी करुण धौर सच्चाई

द्वारा हैं।" (१ कुरिन्थियों द:४-६)। है, श्रर्थात् यीशु मसीह जिसके द्वारा सब वस्तुएं हुईं, और हम भी उसी के जिसकी भोर से सब बस्तुएं हैं, और हम उसी के लिये हैं, भौर एक ही प्रमु बहुत से प्रभु हैं) । तौभी हमारे निकट तो एक ही परमेश्वर है : श्रर्थात्-पिता होती है। एक अन्य स्थान पर वह कहता है, "सो मूरतों के सामने बलि की हुई वस्तुओं के खाने के विषय में—हम जानते हैं, कि मूरत जगत में कोई वस्तुओं के खाने के विषय में—हम जानते हैं, कि मूरत जगत में कोई वस्तु नहीं, भौर एक को छोड़ ओर कोई परमेश्वर नहीं। यद्यपि आकाश में आरे पृथ्वी पर बहुत से ईश्वर कहलाते हैं, (जैसा कि बहुत से ईश्वर और तुम हर बात में देवताओं के बड़े माननेवाले हो।क्योंकि मैं फिरते हुए तुम्हारी पूजने की वस्तुओं को देख रहा था, तो एक ऐसी वेदी भी पाई, जिस पर लिखा था, कि "श्रनजाने ईश्वर के लिये सो जिसे तुम बिना जाने पूजते जी जल गया।" (प्रेरितों १७:१६) । श्रौर श्रागे लिखा है "तब पौलुस ने श्ररियुपगुस के बीच में खड़े होकर कहा ; हे श्रथेने के लोगो मैं देखता हूं, कि मन्दिरों में नहीं रहता, श्रीर न उसे भोजन वा जल इत्यादि की श्रावश्यकता वह सब वस्तुओं का बनाने वाला है, और वह मनुष्य के हाथों से बनाए हुए वह उन्हें श्रागे बताते हुए कहता है कि जिस परमेश्वर की सेवा वह करता है हो, मैं तुम्हें उसका समाचार सुनाता हूं।" (प्रेरितों १७:२२, २३)। श्रीर **उनकी बाट जोह रहा था, तो नगर को मूरतों से भरा हुआ देखकर** उसका इसके अतिरिक्त, नए नियम में, हमें यूं मिलता हैं : "जब पौलुस अथेने में

मूर्तीपूजक, भूठे इत्यादि नरक की आग में डाले जाए गे। सो बाइबल मूर्तीपूजा की निन्दा करती है श्रीर यह भी कहती है कि (प्रकाशितवाक्य

२१-८) । दूसरी स्रोर बाइबल हमें बताती है, तथा सृष्टि, ज्ञान, स्रोर बृद्धि भी हमें सिखाते है कि केवल एक ही परमेश्वर है। (इफिसियों ४:६)। स्रौर वह स्रात्मा है (यूहन्ना ४:२४), तथा हमें केवल उसी की सेवा करनी चाहिए। (१ थिस्सलुनीकियों १:६)।

मसीह की कलीसिया क्या है ?

संसार में ग्राज ग्रनेकों कलीसियाएं विद्यमान् हैं। कई तरह से उन में बहुत समानता है। उन्हें मनुष्यों ने स्थापित किया है। उनका कोई विशेष महत्त्व नहीं है, क्योंकि उनके सदस्य भी यह मानते हैं कि उनका एक सदस्य हुए बिना भी मनुष्य स्वर्ग में पहुंच सकता है। यद्यपि वे बहुतेरे सम्प्रदायों में बटी हुई हैं परन्तु उन सबका एक ही कहना है कि सभी सम्प्रदाय ग्रमने-ग्रपने स्थान पर उचित हैं। वे विभिन्न प्रकार के नामों से कहलाती हैं ग्रीर उन सब के पास ग्रपनी-ग्रपनी विशेष पुस्तकों है जिनके द्वारा वे ग्रपनी उपासना इत्यादि करती हैं। परन्तु केवल एक ही कलीसिया है जो इन सभी संगठनों से बिल्कुल भिन्न है। उसका इनसे किसी भी प्रकार का सम्बन्ध नहीं है। ग्रीर वह है मसीह की कलीसिया।

मसीह की कलीसिया एक सम्प्रदाय नहीं है। यह बहु-साम्प्रदायीक नहीं है। यह कैथलिक नहीं है, प्रोटैस्टैन्ट म्रथवा यहूदी नहीं है। यह एक पंथ नहीं है। इसका म्रारम्भ किसी मनुष्य ने नहीं किया। कोई मनुष्य इसका सिर (प्रधान) नहीं है। पृथ्वी पर इसका कोई भी प्रधान-कार्यालय नहीं है। यह मनुष्यों के नामों द्वारा नहीं कहलाती। यह किसी मनुष्य की लिखी हुई पुस्तक का म्रनुसरण नहीं करती। भीर न ही स्वमाव में यह राजनीतिक म्रथवा समाजिक है। तब यह क्या हो सकती है? म्राईए, इस विषय में देखें।

कलीसिया शब्द को यूनानी भाषा के "एक्कलीसिया" शब्द से लिया गया है, और इसका अर्थ है "बुलाए हुए"। दूसरे शब्द में, कलीसिया उन सब लोगों का एक भुंड है जो प्रमु की सेवा में संसार में से बुलाए गए हैं। पौलुस इस विषय में कहता है, कि वे लोग अंधकार के वश से छुडाए जाकर परमेश्वर के राज्य मर्थात् प्रमु की कलीसिया में मिलाए गए है। (कुलुस्सियों १:१३,

कलीसिया के विषय में बाइबल दो भाव से बताती है। सबसे पहले, इसका उल्लेख सार्वदेशिक भाव से हुम्रा है। यीशु मसीह ने इसी म्रिभिप्राय से कहा था, कि "मैं ग्रपनी कलीसिया बनाऊंगा (मत्ती १६:१८)। इस स्थान पर उसका उद्देश्य कलीसिया के बारे में एक विशाल सार्वदेशिक मन्डली के रूप में बताने का था यहां उसका ग्रिभिप्राय कलीसिया की स्थानीय मन्डलियों से नहीं था। दूसरी ग्रोर, कलीसिया का उल्लेख स्थानीय रूप से भी हुम्रा है, ग्रथीत् विभिन्न स्थानों पर कलीसिया की ग्रनेकों मन्डलियों। इसके बारे में हम अनेकों स्थानों पर पढ़ते हैं, जैसे कि कलीसिया जो कुरिन्थ्य में है, तथा थिस्सलुनीकियों की कलीसिया, इत्यादि। (१ कुरिन्थियों १:२:१; (थिस्सलुनीकियों १:१)। फिर ग्रनेकों मंडलियों को विचार में रखकर पौलुस ने कहा, "तुम को मसीह की सारी कलीसियाग्रों की ग्रोर से नमस्कार।" (रोमियों १६:१६)। इसी दृष्टिकोण से प्रकाशितवाक्य की पुस्तक में ग्रासीया की सात कलीसियाग्रों का वर्णन हुम्रा है।

पृथ्वी पर कलीसिया मसीह की आ्रात्मिक देह के रूप में विद्यमान है। यह उन सब लोगों से मिलकर बनी हुई एक मन्डली है जिन्हों ने उसकी आजाओं को माना है तथा उसकी सेवा में लगे हुए हैं। इस देह में आंग तो बहुतेरे हैं परन्तु इसका केवल एक ही सिर है। (१ कुरिन्थियों ४:४)। और वही देह कलीसिया है। (इफिसियों १:२२,२३)।

यदि श्राप मनुष्यों द्वारा बनाई हुई कलीसियाश्रों के बारे में जानना चाहते हैं, तो अवश्य है कि आप इतिहास इत्यादि की पुस्तकों को पढ़ें। उनके विषय में जानने के लिये आप बाइबल में से नहीं पढ़ सकते क्योंकि प्रमु से उनका कोई सम्बन्ध नहीं है। इसके अतिरिक्त, यदि आप मसीह की कलीसिया के बारे में जानने के इच्छुक हैं तो इसके बारे में आपको केवल बाइबल ही उचित जानकारी दे सकती है। बाइबल केवल कलीसिया के इतिहास तथा कलीसिया से सम्बन्धित हरएक अन्य बात के विषय में ही हम नहीं बताती परन्तु पूर्ण रूप से कलीसिया की अगुवाई भी करती है। (२ तीमुथियुस ३:१६,१७; याकूब १:२५)।

इस कलीसिया को स्वयं मसीह ने स्थापित किया है (मत्ती १६:१८), यरुशलेम नगर में, ३३ ई० स० में। (प्रेरितों २)। इसका अर्थ तब यह हुआ
